A Supported Learning Journey

Swansea offers tailored support throughout the entirety of a student's university journey. Before arriving, your child will have access to our International@campuslife team, who can offer advice on issues such as the visa application process. This team also organises events throughout the year, to encourage international students to meet new friends and experience

All students are matched with a personal tutor whose role is to empower, guide, and support your child through all aspects of academic life, providing support for issues big and small. Students under 18 will benefit from a dedicated under-18s personal tutor, who will be able to assist them with the transition to living away from home.

Throughout their university life, students also have access to the Student Experience team. In their first weeks, this team will ensure all students are settled in and introduced to all the systems they need to begin learning.

On top of this, there are also a number of University team who can assist students in their physical and mental health and financial needs. Our University Faith team is likewise available to help students find communities and places of worship such as our on-campus Mosque.

A Taste of the World

Swansea University has active student societies from all over the world which help students integrate into university life by organising informal events and boasting a full calendar of activities throughout the year. Students are welcome to join any society to experience something new or meet similar people.

There are many international restaurants in Swansea and diet specific food (e.g. Halal) is not hard to find. Additionally, there are several supermarkets and smaller stores which stock global ingredients, making it easy for students to cook their favourite meals from home. St Helens Road is a hot spot for international students, as there are lots of world food stores located along it, as well as an array of restaurants and takeaways.

Safe in Swansea

The College's on-campus accommodation facility is only a 2 minute walk from our teaching building offering comfort, convenience and security.

An integral part of campus life, our friendly team of security professionals provides a 24/7 security service across our campuses.
